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Previously Opening Permission has been accorded to the classes I to VII from the year 2017-18 in respect of Ravindra Bharathi School, Sy.No. 170/8, 170/9 & 171/6A1, Vellanki Village, Anandapuram Mandal, Visakhapatnam District vide in the reference 1st cited.

The Correspondent, Ravindra Bharathi School, Sy.No. 170/8, 170/9 & 171/6A1, Vellanki Village, Anandapuram Mandal, Visakhapatnam District has submitted the application for Provisional Temporary Recognition for classes I to VII classes under English Medium for the years in the school from 2017-18 to 2025-27 in the reference 2nd cited.

The Mandal Educational Officer, Pendurthi has verified the application for Provisional Temporary Recognition with reference to the conditions laid down in the previous orders and G.O.Ms.No.1 Edn., dated 01.01.1994 and submitted report in his letter 4th cited.

The District Educational Officer, Visakhapatnam hereby granted Provisional Temporary Recognition for a period of '10' years i.e., the academic year from 2017-18 to 2026-27 for the classes I to VII (English Medium) in respect of Ravindra Bharathi School, Sy.No. 170/8, 170/9 & 171/6A1, Vellanki Village, Anandapuram Mandal, Visakhapatnam District subject to fulfilment of the following conditions.

1. That the Educational Institution shall serve the needs of the locality more particularly.
2. That the institution shall adopt the curriculum and syllabus prescribed by the Government from time to time.
3. That the school timings vacations and mid-term holidays shall be followed as prescribed by Government from time to time.
4. That the qualified staff within the age limits prescribed by Government for Government employees shall be appointed with the management own funds as per the pattern.
5. That the results of institution shall be satisfactory every year.
6. That the records/ accounts shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer, every year by 30th September at least.
7. That the list of Governing Body shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer, every year.
8. That the pay structure/fee structure fixed by the Government shall be got approved by the District Educational Officer, every year.
9. That all the conditions prescribed in the G.O.s and other orders which are not specified in this order shall be complied with.
10. That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both to the parents/ District Educational Officer, and competent authority at least six months before.
11. That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date which summer vacation is declared.
12. That the society shall submit proposal for Renewal of Provisional Temporary Recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., at least six months prior to the date of expiry of the present recognition.
13. That the society shall provide fire safety measures in the school as per the No objection certificate.
14. The management informed that no thatched roof accommodation is allowed to run the school.
15. Proper and adequate sanitation facility shall be provided for students especially for girl students.
16. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.
17. The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services departments.
18. The parent Teachers Association meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children.
19. The school shall have first aid kit and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
20. The Correspondent of the concerned school is hereby informed to file an affidavit every year to the effect that there is no deviation or violation of the conditions prescribed by the Government from time to time.
21. That the management shall obtain and submit the structural soundness certificate every year before reopening of the School for the academic year.
22. That the management shall take every responsibility for the timely safety and comfortable mobility of the School Children from the residences to School and vice versa.
23. That the School Van should be ensured road worthy for the transportation/ mobility of School Children.
24. That the School Bus should be free from all taxes due and should be maintained with regular checks by authorized mechanism of Periodically/ as and when required without causing any sort of dislocation for the School Children using the bus facility.
25. That the management shall engage skilled experienced and authorized drivers having good health and good vision for the School Van.
26. That the management shall ensure the vehicle and safety glass be provided to the windows of the Vehicle.
27. That the management shall ensure the Accounts of the School audited by an authorized Chartered Accountant every year and submit.
28. The management is hereby informed that the recognition is being given purely on temporary basis and is subject to the report of state level inspection and if committee regarding fulfillment of all the pre-requisite conditions under A.P. Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any pre-requisite stipulated, the recognition now being given is liable to be withdrawn at once.
29. The management should display fee structure and pay structure and qualified teachers list on the notice board.
30. The management shall follow the rules and regulations issued by Traffic Department from time to time. If any complaint received from the Traffic Department Temporary Recognition now issued shall be cancelled at any time without giving notice.
31. The management of the school is hereby requested to file an affidavit by the end of April every year to the effect that there is no deviation or violation of the conditions prescribed by the Govt. from time to time.

If the management fails to comply with the above conditions promptly the Recognition now granted will be reviewed.

Now the Correspondent, Ravindra Bharathi School, S.Y.No.170/8, 170/9 & 171/6A1, Vellanki Village, Anandapuram Mandal, Visakhapatnam District has submitted the application for Provisional Recognition for the class VIII (E.M.) vide reference 7th cited.

In the reference 9th cited, the District Educational Officer, Visakhapatnam has verified the application for Provisional Recognition with reference to the Inspection Report of the Inspecting Officer (vide reference 8th cited) and recommended for provisional recognition from the academic year 2023-24 to 2026-27.

As per the instructions of the Director of School Education, AP, Amaravati vide reference 9th cited read with the G.O.5th cited and under Rule 3 (2) of G.O.Ms.No.1 Education, Dated.01.01.1994, the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Visakhapatnam who is the competent authority, is hereby accorded Provisional Recognition for the class VIII under E.M. in Ravindra Bharathi School, S.Y.No.170/8, 170/9 & 171/6A1, Vellanki Village, Anandapuram Mandal, Visakhapatnam District for a period of four (4) years i.e., from 2023-24 to 2026-27 without Grant-in-Aid now or in future subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

- 5 That the qualified staff within the age limits prescribed by Government for Government employees shall be appointed by the management with own funds as per the staff pattern.

- 6 That the results of institution shall be satisfactory every year.
- 7 That the records / accounts shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer, every year by 30th September at least.
- 8 That the list of Governing Body shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer every year.
- 9 That the pay structure / fee structure fixed by the Governing Body shall be got approved by the District Educational Officer every year.
- 10 That all the conditions prescribed in the said G.O.'s and other orders which are not specified in this order shall be complied with.
- 11 That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both to the parents / District Educational Officer and competent authority at least six months before.
- 12 That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date on which summer vacation is declared.
- 13 That the society shall submit proposal for Renewal of recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., At least six months prior to the date of expire of the present recognition.
- 14 The management is informed that no thatched roof accommodation is allowed to run the School.
- 15 The management shall provide proper adequate Toilets / sanitation facility to the students & Staff.
- 16 Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for the students within the school campus and also near the school premises.
- 17 The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the Police and fire services departments.
- 18 The parent Teachers Associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the students.
- 19 The school shall have first aid kit and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
- 20 That the management shall provide Ramps in the school building for differently abled children.
- 21 That the management of the school is hereby instructed to maintain Fire equipment in the prominent places of the school building.
- 22 That the management shall provide the Annual Administrative Reports of previous recognition period and same should be submitted to the District Educational Officer through the inspecting officer.
- 23 That the management shall provide the Annual Audit reports of this school which were audited by an authorized Chartered Accountant for the years of previous recognition period and same should be submitted to the District Educational Officer through the inspecting officer.
- 24 That the management shall provide ramps for differently abled children in the school building.

If the management fails to comply with the above conditions promptly the Recognition now granted will be reviewed. Receipt of these proceedings should be acknowledged.
